The annual Systemic Symposium of the *Hellenic Institute for the Development of Human Systems* (**HIDeAS** in English or **EIDAS** in Greek), which is the collective interdisciplinary body in the field of Systemic Constellation Work in Greece, is purposed to create "bridges" between academics & scientists with systemic professionals, practitioners, and students of constellation work, for the expansion of Systems Thinking and the enrichment of Systemic Practice. EIDAS Institute-Network is closely associated with **ISCA** (*International Systemic Constellation Association*) in supporting ISCA Hellenic Chapter, headed by Nikos Vayiakkos.

During the two days of the online Symposium, esteemed members from the academic, scientific, and bio-psycho-social fields are invited to share their wisdom and contribute uniquely (and innovatively) to the formation of new consciousness, with respect to human systems and their phenomena.
